

2017 GYPSY



Tasting Notes

Each of the three varietals in this elegant blend adds distinctive aromas and flavors. Grenache contributes raspberry, strawberry and cherry flavors, while the Mourvèdre adds richness to the mid-palate and lengthens the dry finish. Finally, Syrah lends color, tannins and hints of blueberry and black pepper. Together, the finished wines blend into a classic and complex GSM.

66% Grenache, 23% Mourvedre, 11% Syrah

Fermentation: 100% Native Yeast, 7% Whole Cluster (Grenache)
